<sup>2</sup> Disciplinary removals are defined as any instance in which a child is removed from his/her educational placement for disciplinary purposes, including in-school suspension, out-of-school suspension, expulsion, removal by school personnel to an interim alternative educational setting for drug or weapon offenses or serious bodily injury, and removal by a hearing officer for likely injury to self or others. All disciplinary removals for reasons other than VV-SA lasting at least one-half day for students receiving special education and or related services must be reported through the use of the Report of Suspension of Students with Disabilities section of the EVVRS by the school that the student attends. The data are reported annually to the USDE.
